As before, instead of metallic animal targets, competitors aimed at much smaller egg-shaped silhouette targets at the same distances (40, 60, 77, and 100 meters) while shooting off the bench using the regular Sanners rifle range rests and sandbags.

As usual, the competition was tight and the race for the top was neck and neck as the shooters entered their last string, but in the end Jake Swierczek didn't crack under the pressure and took the win with 38 (out of 40) eggs knocked over. Right behind him in second place was Joe Mund, doing very well for his first time out with 34 eggs down. Meanwhile, Mary Picard and Carrie Lee Gissinger battled it out for third place with Mary taking the tie-breaker with 6 hits on the most-distant eggs waaaaay out there at 100 meters.
