

## Sanner's Lake Rimfire Silhouette Match Report – May 2022

The storms of the previous day went on a temporary hiatus and a calm but sticky afternoon greeted four shooters at the first silhouette match of the year at Sanner's Lake. The race to the top was tight, and the scores were excellent across the board, but Mark Swierczek worked his way past a sighting-in struggle, calmed his nerves, and managed to crack all the eggs, becoming only the third person to notch a perfect score of 40 eggs dropped. Greg Banta kept the race close but a couple of near-misses at 100y relegated him to second place, while new silhouette shooter Jeff Heisler knocked over an impressive 33 eggs to take third place, an outstanding score for his first time out!
