The line was populated with a fascinating variety of interesting historical guns including a classic British SMLE and even an original 140-year-old Trapdoor Springfield! When the smoke cleared, however, it was the venerable '03 Springfield of Barry Nutwell dominating the standings, taking first in both the combined (276-2X) and individual (95-1X) score categories. The Garands were right on his heels, though, with Dick Chadwick nabbing second place in the combined category with a 272-1X while Ron Ferguson's 93-2X was good enough for second place in the individual category. Not to be outdone, the classics put up a strong showing with Paul Stephen's SMLE breathing down everybody's neck, taking 4th place in both the combined and individual categories, while Jake Swierczek's Trapdoor from 1889 showed General Custer how it's done as it shredded the scoring rings with .45 caliber daylight to notch a stellar 91-1X, good enough for 6th place in the individual category. In the war of the M1 Carbines, Asher Maroot watched his scores slide along with the rear sight on his Inland allowing the Saginaw of Mary Picard to squeak out a victory with a strong 243-1X combined.

Thanks to everyone for making it out to the range and filling the benches in what might have been our highest turnout yet. Keep those old guns warmed up and sighted in and we'll see you at the next match on May 16th!
