

Sanner's Lake Woodstock Match Report – May 2019

It was a nice, crisp spring afternoon, maybe the last of the pleasant days before the oppressive heat and humidity of summer kick in, and eight shooters either bailed out of work early or ditched their household chores to man the benches and sling lead at the May Woodstock match at Sanners Lake. The usual historically-fascinating assortment of firearms was present including a Remington M1917 “American Enfield” as well as a modern reproduction of an 1885 High Wall Winchester lobbing big slugs of 45-70 caliber lead downrange. In the end, though, it was the '03 Mark I Springfield of Mark Swierczek that nabbed first place, squeaking by the M1917 of Jake Swierczek to take the win in both the combined (273-2X) and individual (95-0X) score categories. Of note, we had to go to the second level of tie-breaker (fewest hits of lowest value) to break the tie for first place individual as well as several other ties further down the line...that's some tight competition! And speaking of competition, the Garands were right in there mixing it up near the top and across the board, but in the end it was Joe Maida's Springfield grabbing third place in the combined category with a fine 265-3X.

Thanks to everyone for taking advantage of the good weather and filling the benches to throw lead downrange in spite of the work and other chores that needed to be done (but could certainly wait another day).
