And after enjoying his first Woodstock match last year with a borrowed rifle, Mike DiZebba came back with his very own Garand this year, taking third place in the combined score category with a solid 259-7X. In the battle of the Carbines, it was Asher Maroot squaring off against new Woodstock shooter John Healy, with Asher kicking things off with a strong 89-1X to take Top Carbine with a superb 257-2X combined, both of which I believe are Woodstock Match M1 Carbine Records! Meanwhile John saw his score increase with each string, so hopefully he'll be back to continue the trend.
