The low sun and long shadows lit up the targets nicely but caused a bit of havoc on the firing line, with shooters taking extraordinary steps including repurposing rifle bags and repositioning spouses (see last picture below) to block the light and maintain a decent sight picture against the backlit glare of the sun! It was a tight race down to the finish with just a few points separating the winners in both the combined and individual score categories. Barry Nutwell put it all together on one string to take the top individual score of the day, a super 94-1X, with Jonathan Ramsey and Paul Stephens following closely with twin 93's, Jonathan taking second place with his higher X-count. A high single score isn't enough to earn the top combined category, though, as Jesse Williams and his Argentine Mauser put rounds consistently down the middle to take first place with a solid 272-7X combined. Verifying that consistency is king, Ron Ferguson and Paul Stephens were hot on Jesse's heels posting twin 271's, with Ron taking second place with his 5 X's. This was the last Woodstock match of the year so thanks to everyone for coming out and providing an outstanding display of shooting and, more importantly, giving the old warhorses a chance to shine once again!
